DEADLINE for scholarship applications is Friday April 23, 2021

Purpose: To provide scholarships to Lake Elsinore Unified School District High School graduating seniors interested in or intending to pursue post-high school course of study at either a college/university or other post-secondary educational institution.

Award Components:

- *(1) \$1000 Scholarship Award per high school,
- (1) \$1000 Scholarship Award for a student majoring in Education
- (1) \$1000 Scholarship for a student majoring in the area of Environmental Science

* Number of scholarships is subject to change

Criteria:

1. Applicant must attend high school within the Lake Elsinore Unified School District
2. Applicant must be a graduating high school senior
3. Applicant must be eligible and plan to attend classes as a full time student at an accredited vocational school, junior college, four year college or university during the 2021-2022 academic year.
4. Scholarship awards will be based on financial need, academic performance and community involvement.

Application Process: Applicant must submit the following items:

1. Completed application form
2. Personal Essay – Tell us about yourself and describe your educational goals, planned major of study and objectives? (500 words or less)

Applications received after the Friday April 23, 2021 deadline, may not be considered.

Funds will be disbursed to the Financial Aid Office of the post-secondary school, once the recipient provides proof of enrollment and registration of classes in the Fall of 2021.
